

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ADVISORY ELECTION BY THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF DUNES CITY ON THE QUESTION OF CONSTRUCTION OF A MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM IN DUNES CITY, OREGON, AND DIRECTING THAT NOTICE BE GIVEN.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNES CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. - The Common Council of the City of Dunes City, Lane County, Oregon, does hereby order that an advisory election be held on Friday, September 12, 1969 in the City of Dunes City, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., Pacific Daylight Time, at which election the registered voters of the City of Dunes City shall cast their ballot on the following question:

"Shall the City of Dunes City, Lane County, Oregon, proceed with the necessary planning, surveying, and engineering projects necessary for the construction and installation of a municipal water system in the City of Dunes City, Oregon, to be financed wholly by the sale of revenue bonds, which bonds shall be retired solely from the revenue arising from the operation of said Municipal Water System?"

The polling place for the registered voters of the City of Dunes City shall be at the Siuslaw Rural Fire Protection District fire station, on Clear Lake Road, Tsiltcoos Heights, in Dunes City, Oregon.

Section 2. - The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to publish the notice of said election by publication prior to such election once each week for four consecutive weeks in The Siuslaw News, Florence, Lane County, Oregon. The City Recorder is further authorized and directed to post notices of said election in four public places within the City of Dunes City for a period of four successive weeks prior to said election.
