**ORDINANCE 94**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DUNES CITY NUISANCE ABATEMENT ORDINANCE.**

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to extend the abatement authority contained in Ordinance 51 so as to allow the city to enforce its Ordinance relating to dog control by exercising its abatement powers.

WHEREAS, the City of Dunes City, Lane County, Oregon has received numerous complaints relating to dogs running at large, barking for extended periods of time, and engaging in other nuisance behavior, and

WHEREAS, it appears that this kind of conduct is beyond the scope of the enforcement powers contained within the nuisance abatement ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the City of Dunes City chooses to extend the scope of its police powers, by extending its abatement powers and authorities contained in Ordinance 51 to encompass certain objectionable activities engaged in by dogs, and

**THEREFORE THE CITY OF DUNES CITY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

That Ordinance 51 is amended in that the language "except for paragraph 1a and 1b of Section I" be deleted from paragraph 1, Section II in Ordinance No. 51.

**THE CITY DOES FURTHER ORDAIN** that an emergency exists, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
