

ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING CERTAIN TYPES OF HUNTING AND TRAPPING WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 33.

Dunes City ordains as follows:

Section 1. Hunting and trapping prohibited. Except as provided by section 2, ORS 498.158 is applicable within the city and no person shall hunt or trap any wildlife within the city.

Section 2. Exception. The hunting of gamebirds with a shotgun, and the trapping of wild furbearing animals is allowed within the city. A person engaged in the activities described in this section is responsible for conformance with all other applicable laws and regulations.


Section 3. Penalty. A violation of section 1 is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.

Section 4. Repeal. Ordinance No. 33, enacted September 14, 1970, is repealed.
