AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 50 BY DELETING SECTION 9-VIII-B-2 (PUBLIC NEED)

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 50, Section 9-VIII-B-2 requires that an applicant requesting a re-zoning must demonstrate a public need that is best achieved by the re-zoning, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 50 requires a positive finding of public need but contains no definition of public need or criteria concerning public need, and

WHEREAS "public need" is difficult to prove because it is not easily defined, and

WHEREAS other cities have deleted this requirement from their ordinances, codes and comprehensive plans, and

WHEREAS the Council of Dunes City has determined that it would be in the best interests of its citizens to eliminate the criterion "public need",

THEREFORE DUNES CITY ORDAINS that the provision contained in Ordinance No. 50, Section 9-V-III-B-2, which reads:

"It has been demonstrated that there is a public need for the proposed change, and that the need is best achieved by this proposal."

is hereby deleted from Dunes City Ordinance No. 50 and from criteria required for rezoning of land.
